



HEATHER FIRST SNEACHDA

Scotland is a country in which heather has a special place of honor. Its stems produce a yellow dye from which Scotland's famous woolen blankets and kilts are made.

Heather has another use, in the production of traditional Heather Ale — a legendarily strong kind of beer with a history dating back as far as the 2nd century BC. Heather was also displayed on the coat of arms of one of the Scottish clans. Ancient Scottish legend claims that the simple heather was the only thing which God allowed to grow on the wild and windswept slopes of the Highlands. In return, God granted the heather its heightened durability and natural charm — along with its fragrance, and its part in producing honey.
