



PYRAMID SMOKEY

Pyramids of stone have been built all over the world. Tibetan monks believe these pyramids serve as homes for the souls of the faithful, when visiting the sacred shrines during prayer and meditation. In Norway pyramids are called trolls. They have a belief that whoever builds a stone pyramid on a mountain peak gives life to a young troll, and brings good fortune to their life.

Today, tourist routes are often set up to follow these ancient reference points. In ancient times, such constructions were built as monuments, grave markers, or they had practical uses, such as astronomy. In Canada's maritime provinces they were frequently used for purposes such as lighthouses, to aid ships with their navigation.
